ACCOMMODATION

42% of young people said that their living conditions had improved over the past 3 years

FALSE

42% said that conditions had got worse

**Some Gypsy/Travellers in Scotland
speak a language which has its roots in
Sanskrit**

SCHOOL

**71% reported that conditions at school
were either the same or worse**

TRUE

- **24% said that conditions had got worse**
- **47% said that conditions had stayed the same**

After a Gypsy/Traveller family has lived in a house for two years they are no longer classed as Gypsy/Travellers

FALSE

Born a Traveller, always a Traveller

HEALTH

13% of young people asked said that getting access to a doctor or dentist had become easier over the last 3 years

TRUE

13% said that access had got easier

**A recent health study showed that
Gypsy/Travellers who suffered the
poorest health were those living on
roadside camps**

FALSE

**Gypsy/Travellers who travelled least (in
houses) have the poorest health - especially
depression and anxiety**

DISCRIMINATION

The place that young people say they suffer the most discrimination is in the streets

TRUE

The most common place was in the street (77%) followed by school (75%) and in the shops (63%)
